MAPP Notice

Dear Student

If you are an undergraduate student who has 60 hours or more in your particular program, in order to comply with the Southern Association of Colleges and Schools (SACS) accreditation and for Troy to improve, we are requiring you to take the MAPP exam. If you do not take this exam this Spring (2010), **you may not enroll for Summer 2010.** **There is No Fee for this exam.**

The MAPP test Standard Form contains 108 questions and can be administered in two hours. The test consists of two 60-minute sections. It provides a total score for each student and a full range of group mean data. Students receive a total score as well as results in each of the sub-score areas. Test results provide colleges with norm-referenced results for the group in the following areas:

Reading	Critical Thinking	Humanities	Natural Sciences
Writing	Mathematics	Social Sciences	Total Score
